ADMISSION :

The minimum age limit for the L.K.G. class is 3½ years but less than 4 ½ years as on 01.06.2019 (Add year(s) in the chronological order for all other classes). The school authorities believe in the numerical composition of classes which can be effectively and efficiently managed so that individual attention is given to the students.

Following particulars are to be produced at the time of admission.

1. Birth Certificate
2. Transfer Certificate
3. Character and Conduct Certificate
4. Community Certificate
5. Aadhaar Card

Parents must accompany the pupil at the time of admission.

If the fees is not paid within the stipulated time, the name of the student will be removed from the rolls.

WITHDRAWAL :

A parent may apply to the Principal for Transfer Certificate giving details of the pupil and the reason for withdrawal after paying all the dues to the school. The Transfer Certificate will be issued within 3 days of the receipt of the letter.

Removal and Readmission :

When a student seeks readmission after a lapse of one clear month, he / she need to pay the tuition fee and the readmission fee for the period in between the removal and readmission months.

DURATION OF COURSE AND SCHEME OF STUDIES :

The School is Co-Educational and follows CBSE Curriculum.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION :

Physical education ensures physical and mental fitness of children. Moreover, to lead a disciplined life, students should take an interest in all the physical education activities of the school.

HOUSE SYSTEM :

The school has evolved a Four-House system for conducting competitions in various fields – sports, literary, cultural, etc. Competitions like debate, quiz, essay writing, short-story writing, declamation, music, painting, dance etc. are conducted as part of House activities.

The system provides opportunities for children to develop leadership qualities and to grow as full-fledged personalities. A healthy competitive spirit is nourished by awarding the winning House a Cock House Shield.

CLUBS :

The school has atleast 7clubs galvanising various activities periodically. Students' talents are developed through club activities. Educational trips to historical, cultural and science centres are arranged.

EXAMINATIONS

1. Subject Enhancement Tests such as Periodic Tests, and Revision Tests Tests and Terminal Examinations will be conducted for the academic year 2024-2025.

2. Pupils absent for an examination, for any reason, will not be re-examined.

3. Any student caught using unfair means during examination is liable to be summarily removed from the rolls and a transfer certificate issued.

4. Every child should study about two hours in the evenings and one hour in the mornings during school days and longer hours during holidays to face the examinations with confidence.

5. The school does not guarantee the success of pupils' study unless the parents / guardians cooperate with the school authority and do their part by enforcing regularity and discipline.

6. Results once declared will not be reconsidered.

GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLINE AND ATTENDANCE

1. The School Calendar Cum Diary should be carried by the student everyday to the school. The rules of attendance and discipline as given in the school calendar should be strictly followed.

2. Every pupil is required to have an attendance of not less than 85% of the working days in a school year, failing which the chances of promotion to the next class may be doubtful.

3. Students will report to school only between 8.45 AM – 9.00 PM. School authorities are not responsible for students who reach before the specified time.

4. Children suffering from infectious diseases will not be allowed to attend the classes. Only on producing the medical certificate from a competent medical officer, they will be allowed to attend the classes. Other children belonging to the same family should also be kept at home till such time they are totally free from infection.

5. Parents are requested to inform personally the Principal/ the class teacher about any specific illness (like heart problem, juvenile diabetes, asthma, epilepsy, seizures etc.) the student is suffering from. The necessary medical report and the precautions to be taken should also be submitted to the school authorities to enable them to act appropriately. The same should be recorded in the student's diary.
